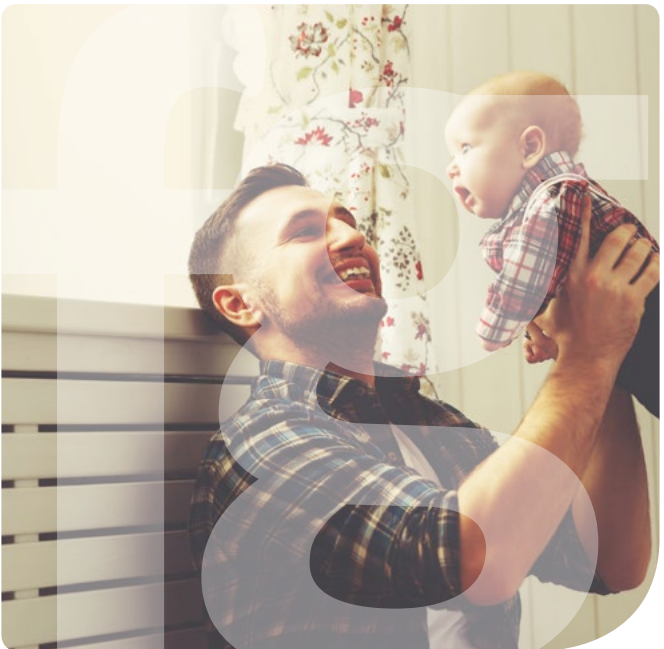

# gleich=berechnet at a glance

## What is gleich=berechnet?

gleich=berechnet is an **online-calculator** to visualise the joint household income during and after parental leave.

## How does gleich=berechnet work?

The tool allows calculating and comparing different options of child care allowance, part-time and full-time work in four steps.

At one glance the disposable monthly income of your household, if child care is shared equally among parents, is visible.

Using gleich=berechnet after your parental leave helps to estimate how an equal distribution of paid work and child care can work financially, e.g. by working in (parental) part-time for both parents.

## Who can use gleich=berechnet?

The calculator provides orientation for employed parent couples living in Austria as exact as possible.

# How does gleich=berechnet work?

With gleich=berechnet you need three simple steps for your result:

## Step 1: Information on your child/ren

Calculations can be done for born and unborn children alike. Simply enter the following information:

- the number of children you have and/or are expecting;
- the (expected) month of birth for each child.

## Step 2: Information on first parent

Here you enter information on the income of the first parent - income from employment, or child care allowance (Kinderbetreuungsgeld - KBG), or both.

- Provide the gross or net income.
- If you (want to) receive KBG, choose your preferred option.
- Additional income can be indicated too, if you work parallel to the receipt of KBG.

## Step 3: Information on second parent

The income of the second parent can be indicated in the same way as for the first parent. **Please note:** In principle, KBG cannot be received parallel by both parents during the whole period. If you want to calculate for alternating the KGB, please adapt the income inputs for both parents accordingly.

## Step 4: Result

As result, the overall monthly net income of your household based on your inputs and the family benefits is calculated.

# What additional functions does gleich=berechnet have?

Following your calculation you can **change your inputs** to recalculate your household's income with another model of child care allowance, or with changed weekly working hours.

Also, a **comparative calculation** is possible, to directly compare different options.

You can access your calculation again later. To this end, you can create an **individual link** which can be saved or sent.

Furthermore, you may **download a PDF** of your calculations.
